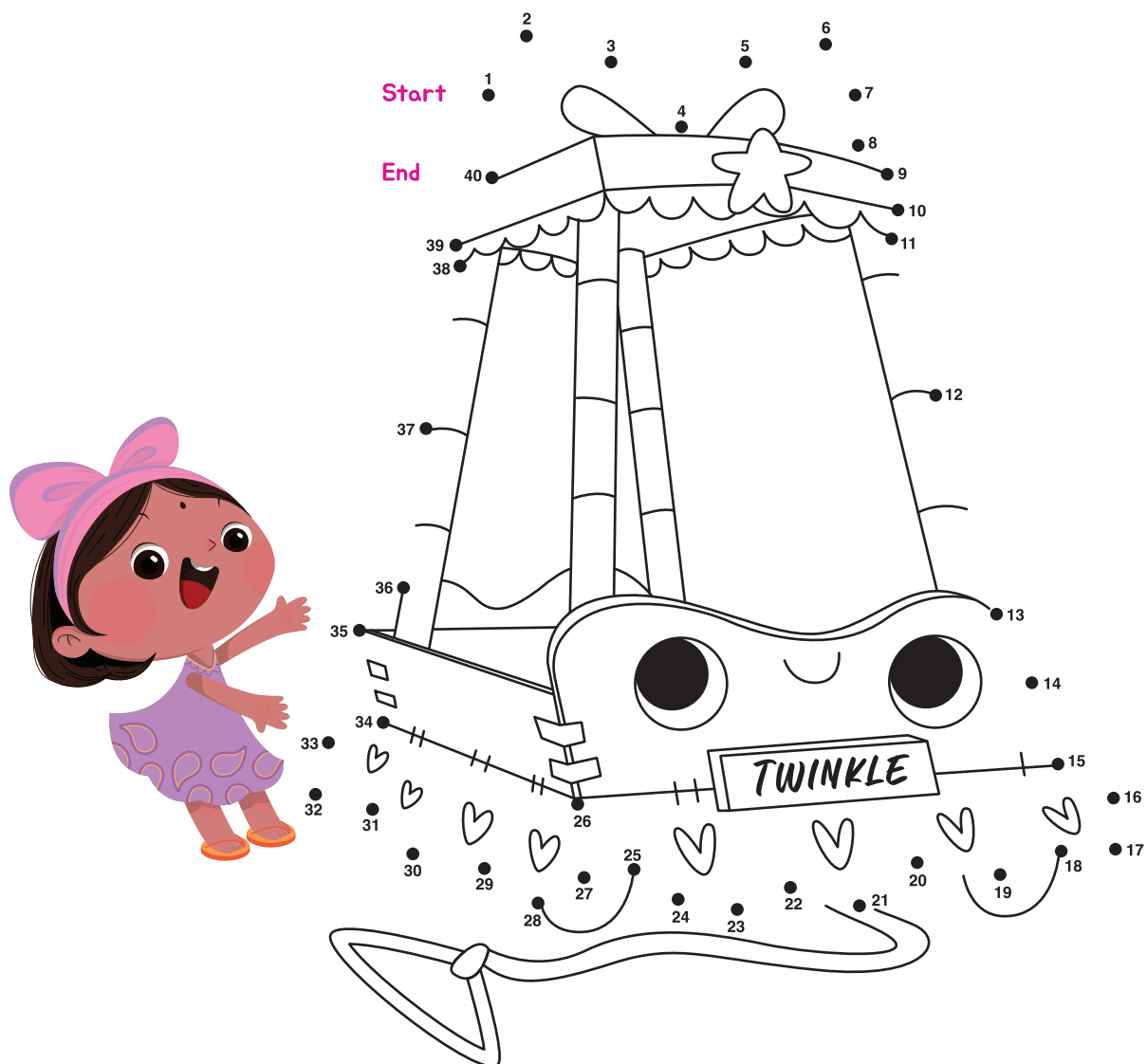

HELP your friends when they need it

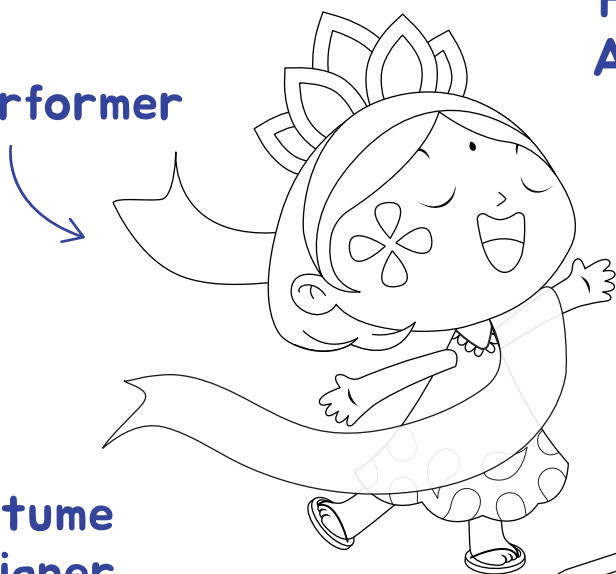


I am a Chingay Volunteer!

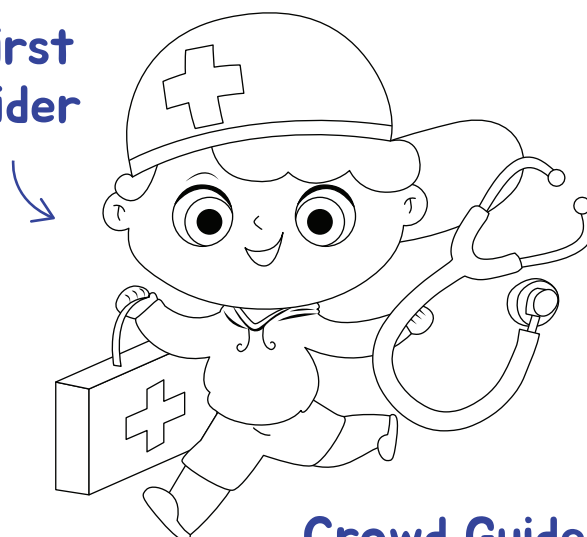
Imagine someone who really loves to help simply because it makes others smile. That's what a volunteer is! They're like superheroes who put their heart into making Chingay even more joyful.

Helping others adds colour to the spirit of Chingay, just like these volunteers do. Can you add your favourite colours to bring these everyday heroes to life?

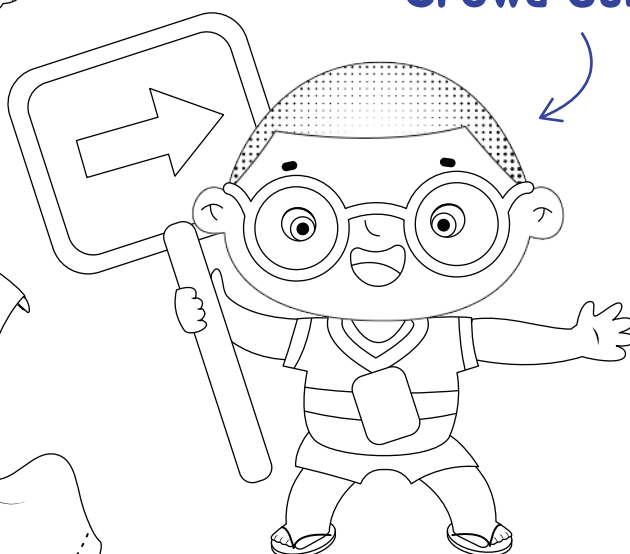

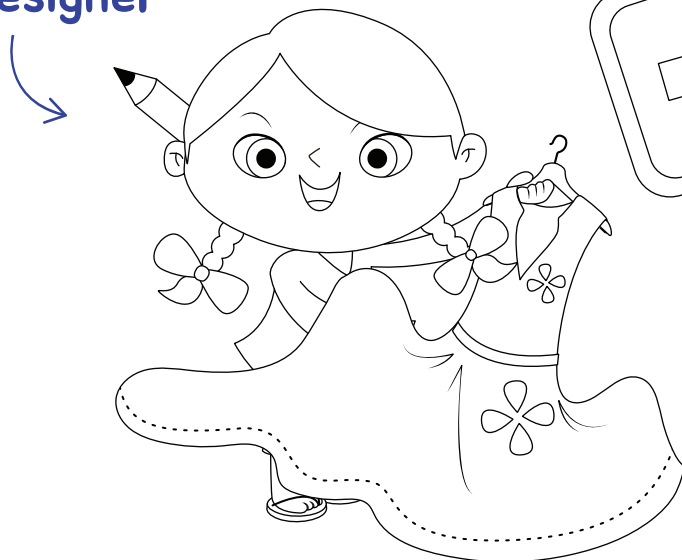

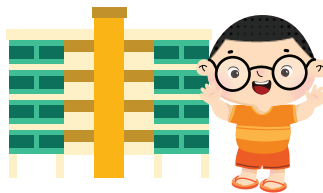

Chingay is a people's parade celebrating multiculturalism with elaborate costumes, colourful floats and cultural performances.

Chingay means "The Art of Costume & Masquerade"



'Chingay' means the art of costume and masquerade in the Hokkien dialect — dressing up in costumes and putting on performances.

It's for Everyone!



People from different ages, races and cultures take part — Chinese, Malay, Indian, Eurasian and many others.

4 Chingay started in 1973!



Chingay began as a humble street parade, and is one of Singapore's biggest celebrations now — full of colours, music and smiles during the Chinese New Year period!
