If you are currently a **Secondary 4 (Express)** student or a student studying an equivalent programme in a Singapore Secondary School and would like to continue your A-level studies with our Dunmanian family, you may consider applying for admission through Direct School Admission-Junior College (DSA-JC) Exercise. Participation in DSA-JC is based on achievements and talents that students can demonstrate beyond the GCE 'O' Level Examination. You will find important information about Dunman High School DSA-JC on this website.

Parents and students are encouraged to choose schools wisely based on the students' aptitudes and strengths, taking into consideration the range of programmes offered in various schools. Students who are successfully admitted to a school via DSA-JC are **expected to honour their commitment to the school and to participate in activities related to the talent selected in, for the duration of the programme admitted to.** They are not allowed to participate in the Joint Admissions Exercise (JAE). They will also not be allowed to transfer to another school after the release of the GCE O-Level examination results. Students who do not fulfil their DSA commitment without valid reason may be required to transfer out to another school.

Notification of Results	All shortlisted applicants who have participated in the selection will be informed of the outcome between <u>28 Jul and 11 Aug 2026</u> .
