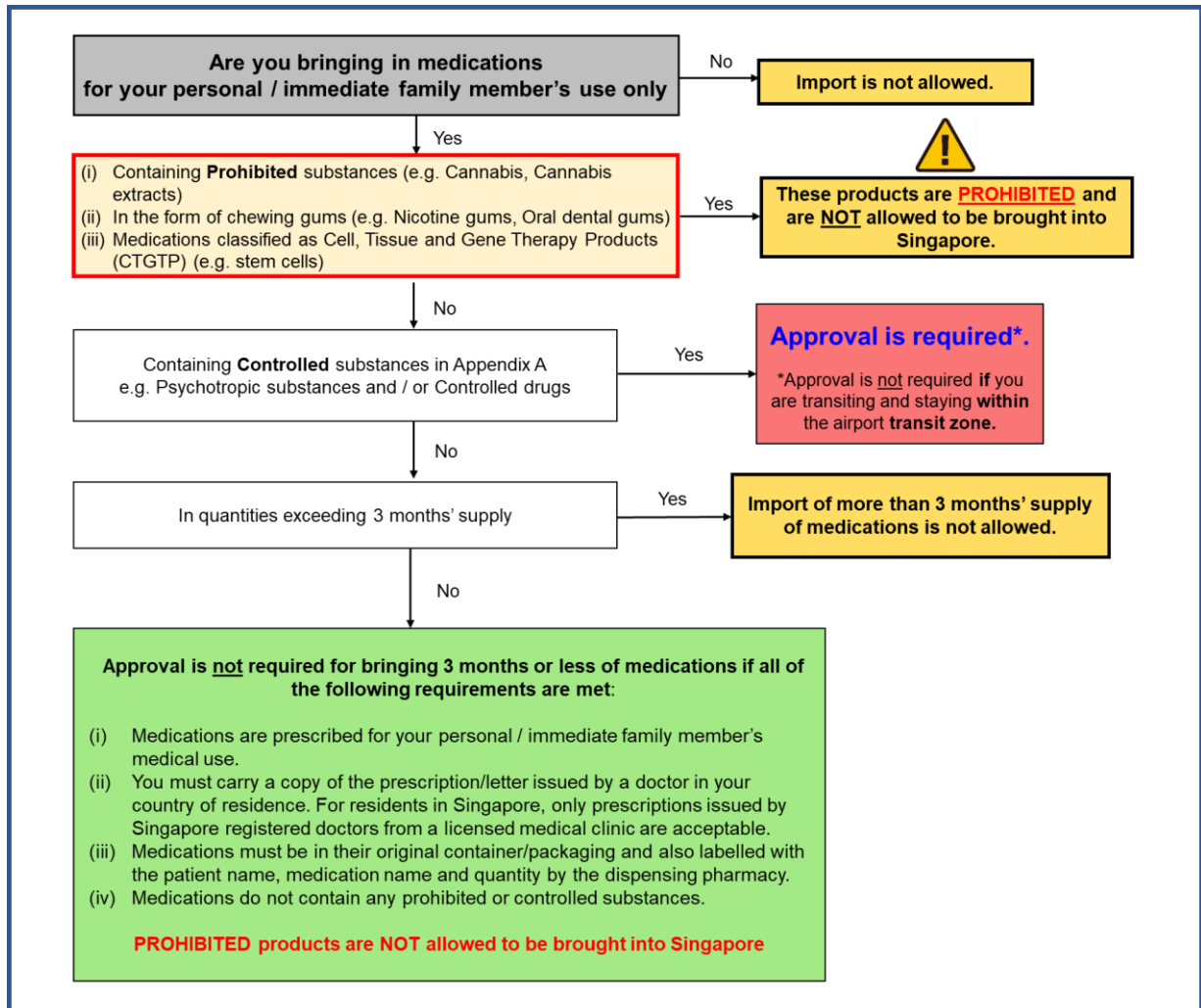


Document guide for bringing in personal medications
