**Mobility Scooter-Lookalikes**

<p>Classified as Personal Mobility Aids (PMAs)</p>	<p>Classified as Personal Mobility Devices (PMDs) or e-scooters</p>
<p>Should be used by persons <b>certified with relevant medical needs*</b>  <i>*To be implemented in 2026</i></p>	<p>Must comply with device criteria and <b>certified to the UL2272 standard</b>                  Devices must also be inspected and registered with LTA</p>
<p>Have <b>only one seat</b> to carry the individual with mobility challenges</p>	<p>Typically have <b>more than one seat</b> for pillion rider(s)</p>
<p>Can be used on pedestrian-only paths, footpaths, cycling paths and shared paths, <b>cannot be used on roads</b></p>	<p>Can be used on <b>cycling paths and shared paths only</b></p>
