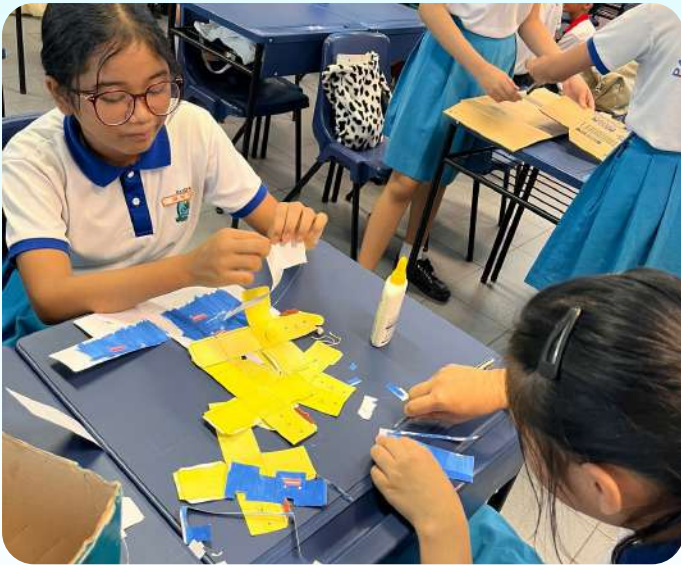


# P6 CHILDREN'S MARKET & DANCE
