

The Eco-Warriors Competition

Rules

1. Eco-Warriors Competition Overview

- a) The National Library Board is organising the Eco-Warriors competition which seeks to reward green advocates amongst our community who practise eco-friendly habits or follow a sustainable lifestyle.
- b) There will be an individual category and a family category. Five winners will be awarded \$300 each under the individual category and 3 winners will be awarded \$500 each under the family category.
- c) Participants need to send in their submissions by 17 Dec 2021 using the template attached.

2. How can I take part?

- a) Submit your sharing (in English only) on why you or your family are Eco-Warriors using the Powerpoint (.ppt) template attached [here](#).
- b) Upload your .ppt file submission and contact details using the form [here](#).
- c) Please keep to a maximum of 3 slides and 6 images within the .ppt file.
- d) Please keep to the template provided.
- e) Please ensure that the maximum size of the .ppt file is no larger than 7 MB.
- f) Incomplete submissions or submissions that do not follow the guidelines above will not be taken into consideration.
- g) Finalists must be able to participate in a presentation and publicity activities, e.g. interviews (see details at paragraph 8 below)

3. Who can participate?

- a) This competition is open to any person living in Singapore. You do not have to be an NLB member to take part.

b) NLB advisors, employees and suppliers involved in organising this competition (and members of their respective immediate families) cannot enter this competition.

4. Can I participate more than once?

Each participant can only submit one entry (either in the individual or family category only).

5. Can I participate with my family?

Participants can join the competition along with their families under the family category of the Eco-Warriors Competition.

6. How are the finalists short-listed?

Five finalists from the individual category and 3 finalists from the family category will be short-listed at NLB's sole discretion based on the following criteria:

Criteria	Weightage
Impact of eco-friendly lifestyle, habits or practices shared	40%
Practicality and reproducibility of proposed practice, habits or lifestyle	40%
Community Vote	20%

All shortlisting decisions are final.

7. When and how will you announce the finalists?

The finalists will be notified via email by 8 Jan 2022.

8. Important note for Eco-Warriors finalists:

- a) Finalists must prepare a short 5-minute spoken presentation in English based on their .ppt submissions. Any .ppt used in the presentation must be the same as the one submitted.
- b) Finalists from the family category can do the sharing as a group or nominate one or more of their teammates to do the presentation. (The format of presentation is subject to change, based on prevailing social distancing guidelines.)
- c) All finalists must agree to be interviewed (either in person or online at NLB's discretion) for a short video that may be posted on NLB's online or social media platforms.
- d) The finalists' submissions will be showcased on the community wall at Choa Chu Kang Public Library for public voting which will make up 20% of the final score.
- e) NLB may replace initial finalists selected if any of the terms of this paragraph 8 are not met.

9. Important note on the finals event of the Eco-Warriors competition:

- b) All finalists are required to give a live in-person presentation before our panel of judges at Choa Chu Kang Public Library. The judges' decisions will make up 80% of the final score. (The format of presentation is subject to change, based on prevailing social distancing guidelines.)

- c) Prizes will be presented in person during the results segment to the respective winner(s).
- d) Finalists are required to stay throughout the entire event.
- e) The winners will be selected under the rules of this competition and all decisions are final.
- f) Note that NLB may, at its discretion, change the event to an online format by notice given via email and if so, the winners will be notified via email to collect prizes on a later date.

10. General

- a) Participants must ensure that they have the right to use the content (e.g. text and images) in their submissions and must not infringe any rights belonging to others or breach any laws.
- b) NLB does not claim any copyright to the submissions.
- c) All participants grant NLB the perpetual right to exhibit, present, publish and archive their submissions, videos and recordings of their presentations in print, online or on any media for any purposes without the payment of any fee.
- d) Unexpected circumstances may require NLB to change the rules or prizes at any time or to cancel the competition at NLB's sole discretion.
