

Blk 842, 844, 846 & 848 in Sims Ave Visitors Covid-19 Swab Test Appointment

The Ministry of health is encouraging members of the public who had visited Block 842, 844, 846 & 848 Sims Ave between 6 to 20 July 2021 to come forward for a free swab between 22 to 24th Jul.

If you had visited the above mentioned blocks during the stipulated period, you may:

Please note that:

- Swabbing for children for this purpose is available at Fullerton Health (≤ 12 years old); and Raffles Hospital (> 6 years old). RSCs do not provide swab tests for children ≤ 12 years old.
- For individuals who are feeling ill (e.g. have a cough, fever, runny nose or loss of smell), please see your doctor or visit a SASH PHPC. Only asymptomatic individuals will be accepted at the RSCs and the other testing venues. Individuals may also be redirected to another testing venue in the event that the RSCs are crowded so that we can maintain safe distancing measures at these venues.

1. This Online Appointment Booking Form is for individuals (aged 13 years and above) who would like to schedule a swab test at a designated RSC.

2. Individuals will only need to bring along their photo identification and declare the date that these premises. The costs of these tests will be fully borne by the Government.
