ENROLLED NURSE LICENSURE EXAMINATION

The SNB Enrolled Nurse (EN) Licensure Examination (LE) aims to assess the candidates' competencies and skills based on SNB's Core Competencies and Generic Skills for Enrolled Nurse, (2023). This is required to assure that foreign qualified nurses can perform safely and effectively as a Enrolled Nurse (EN) in Singapore.

1. A nurse is working in the post-anaesthesia care unit (PACU). Unless contraindicated, clients in PACU should be nursed in which position?

2. Which of the following action/s are considered as therapeutic communication techniques in the nurse-client relationship?

3. What should be the IMMEDIATE intervention if a client on intravenous infusion presents with phlebitis?
