

Singapore Food Insights Database (SG FoodID)

Terms of Use

1. Agreement – Terms

The Singapore Food Insights Database (“SG FoodID”) is an initiative of the Health Promotion Board (“HPB”), a statutory body established under the Health Promotion Board Act 2001. SG FoodID is intended to provide a publicly accessible, central source of nutritional information on most food products sold in Singapore. SG FoodID is designed to support HPB’s mission of fostering good health and healthy living by equipping individuals, researchers, and industry stakeholders with reliable, consolidated data to inform healthier food choices and nutrition-related initiatives. By providing a single, centralised repository of food product information, SG FoodID enables users to better understand the nutritional value of products available in the marketplace. While HPB endeavours to ensure that the information within SG FoodID is comprehensive and up to date, the nutritional information provided is subject to inherent limitations. You are encouraged to exercise your own judgement and seek professional dietary or medical advice where appropriate. HPB makes this resource available as part of its broader commitment to promoting informed decision-making, disease prevention, and overall public health in Singapore
